Terroirs of Les Tatzes and Combe d'Enfer (gneiss),  
490 to 640 metres above sea level.

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## **Wine**

This is a rare vintage, as it is not produced every year: in good years, it impresses with its intense fruitiness when young (blackcurrant, blueberry) and its toasted notes. It is a structured, very dense wine that takes time to develop.

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## **Wine-making**

Partial or total whole bunch vinification, ageing in used casks and barrels for 12 to 18 months, then in bottles for 3 to 18 months.
