
Petite Arvine - En Anzé



Terroir In Anzé, at an altitude of 530 metres. Sandy loam soil. These are fairly deep loess soils on moraines, with a very low clay content. The soil texture is somewhat similar to that found in the commune of Fully, but with a notable difference in the limestone content, which is much higher here.

Wine

Produced from one of the finest terroirs in Saillon, this Petite Arvine offers aromas of citrus, orange blossom and jasmine. The palate is full-bodied, rich yet fresh, perfectly dry, with a finish that could be described as mineral.

Wine-making

Vinification and ageing in vats for 10 months on lees, then in bottles for 3 months.
