
Petite Arvine - les Seyes



Seyes terroir, 600 to 650 metres above sea level. Lateral glacial moraines on gneiss, buried under loess and scree, known as 'grey soils' by winegrowers.

Wine

Thanks to its sunny, crystalline terroir, it offers spicy citrus notes and a hint of rock water. The wine is powerful yet refined, luminous, with heightened salinity and freshness. An expressive Arvine from a great location.

Wine-making

Vinification and ageing in casks for 10 to 18 months depending on the vintage, then in bottles for 3 months.
